4.5 TENDER FOR SPORTSGROUND LIGHTING UPGRADE 2021-2022

RECOMMENDATION*

That Council:

- 1. Awards the tender from Commlec Services Pty Ltd for Sportsground Lighting Upgrade 2021-2022 Contract No. 2022003 for the fixed Lump Sum Price of \$1,046,715.18 with an extra \$157,014 for Contingencies.
- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract agreement;
- 3. Notes that the contract will commence on 4 October 2021 and the expected completion date is 11 March 2022; and
- 4. Notes that the anticipated project expenditure including the fixed Lump Sum, Contingencies, Project Management & Delivery Fees and Provisional Items is \$1,292.864.10

(*Please note that all dollar figures are GST Inclusive unless stated otherwise).

INTRODUCTION

Council has conducted a tender for Sportsground Lighting Upgrade 2021-2022.

BACKGROUND

Council is seeking to appoint Commlec Services Pty Ltd for the supply and installation of sports lighting at Pinewood Reserve, Southern Reserve, Capital Reserve and Mulgrave Reserve.

The State Government has contributed \$1.6 million of funding from the Community Sports Infrastructure Stimulus Program 2021-2022. The Lighting Up Monash Program is funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria and Council to deliver sportsground lighting upgrades at six reserves.

This contract pertains to four of the six sites; Pinewood Reserve, Southern Reserve, Capital Reserve and Mulgrave Reserve.

The new LED floodlighting will improve the accessibility and functionality of the park and better accommodate the needs of current and future users in a number of ways including:

- Enhanced sport and recreation participation opportunities;
- Improved participant, spectator and recreational safety;

- Effective management of light spill to surrounding residences;
- Compliance with sporting infrastructure and lighting standards; and
- Improved energy efficiency.

NOTIFICATION

A public notice was placed in The Age newspaper on 4 August 2021 and the tender closed on 20 August 2021.

Four (4) tender submissions were received by the appointed closing time. The tenders received are listed below:

TENDER CONFORMANCE:

All submissions were assessed for their compliance with the tender conditions including the contractual terms and conditions and the requirements of the response schedules.

Three (3) submissions were deemed non-conforming and these submissions were not evaluated further.

All members of the evaluation panel signed Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality forms and no conflicts were raised.

DISCUSSION

The one conforming tender submission was assessed against the tender evaluation criteria (including the price and non-price evaluation criteria). Reference checks were also undertaken that verified the tenderer's recent past experience delivering sports lighting projects noting the contractor's high level organisational skills in coordinating projects and the ease of delivery. Referees recommended the work of Commlec Services Pty Ltd and their proactive attitude towards problem solving.

As such the evaluation panel recommends Commlec Services Pty Ltd as representing the best value outcome for Council.
