Ref: Naming of Capital Reserve Pavilion Social Rooms the BROOKE CALDER SOCIAL ROOMS

I write on behalf of the Glen Waverley Hawks Sports Club Inc and the Glen Waverley Hawks Cricket Club following the letter from Mr. Tony Oulton dated 25<sup>th</sup> November 2021 in response to our letter dated the 17<sup>th of</sup> October 2021 and our meeting with you and Belinda of today.

The club have asked me to seek Council approval to name the Pavilion Social Rooms at Capital Reserve in honor of a Life Member of both clubs, the BROOKE CALDER SOCIAL ROOMS.

Brooke died in April of this year because of cancer at the age of 45 following an 18-month battle where at one stage he was in remission. He leaves a wife Renee and two small boys in Fletcher (4 years) and Henley (2 years). The club feels that naming the social rooms would be a fitting tribute to Brooke and give his two sons and wife a place to remember their father and husband for years to come.

Brooke is a life member of the GWHSC Inc and the GWHCC. He first played for the club as a 14-year-old and lived in the City of Monash from 1983 until 2000 and then in adjoining LGA of Knox and Whitehorse. At the time of his death, he was a Director of Mutual Trust Ltd. A measure of the esteem Brooke held in the community was that Council allowed the family to hold the funeral service at Capital Reserve in a marque on the oval in late April (between lock downs) in which 350+ people attended and Mutual Trust Ltd organized a live telecast to Sydney & Perth offices but also to other people who could not participate.

Both clubs fully support the naming of the pavilion social rooms the BROOKE CALDER SOCIAL ROOMS in recognition of the services he gave to all.
