4.3 TENDER FOR VISION STREET, CHADSTONE - ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

RECOMMENDATION*

That Council:

- 1. Awards the tender from Delfino Paving Pty Ltd for Vision Street, Chadstone Road Reconstruction, Contract No. 2023004 for the fixed Lump Sum price of \$679,445.58 with an extra \$101,200 for Contingencies, and \$138,116 for Provisional Items;
- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract agreement;
- 3. Notes that the contract is anticipated to commence on 31 October 2022 and the expected completion date is 30 May 2023; and
- 4. Notes that the anticipated project expenditure including the fixed Lump Sum, Contingencies, Project Management & Delivery Fees and Provisional Items is \$951,761.58

(*Please note that all dollar figures are GST Inclusive unless stated otherwise).

INTRODUCTION

Council has conducted a tender for Vision Street, Road Reconstruction.

As part of its planning process for this tender, Council Officers considered its procurement options, including whether to go to market itself, participate in regional or sector collaboration or to access established contracts via other compliant Procurement agreements. Due to the site-specific complexities of this project which are unique to the city of Monash, it was decided to procure this project independently.

BACKGROUND

Council is seeking to appoint a contractor to undertake the reconstruction of Vision Street, Chadstone.

DISCUSSION

The tender panel evaluated all tender submissions ranking Delfino Paving Pty Ltd highest based upon the weighted criteria (including the price and non-price evaluation criteria).

The tender evaluation panel interviewed Delfino to verify and satisfy itself of their capability to deliver this contract to meet the required outcomes of quality, timeframe & budget.

Delfino demonstrated a good understanding of the proposed works and good management of every aspect of the project. They highlighted a number of key risks associated with the construction, particularly the long lead time associated with concrete pipe supply.

Delfino has previously delivered projects of similar nature and size for neighbouring Councils which were completed satisfactorily and to a good quality of finish. Referee checks confirmed Delfino's expertise, resources and proven record to successfully deliver the proposed works verifying the evaluation panel's assessment.

As such, the evaluation panel recommends Delfino Paving Pty Ltd as representing the best value outcome for Council.
