8.1 NOM NO. 17 VICTRACK OWNED LAND TO THE NORTH OF 65A POWER AVENUE, CHADSTONE

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MOTION

That Council:

- 1. Commits to exploring and delivering a new shared path abutting the land at 65A Power Avenue, Chadstone.
- 2. Directs Council's CEO or her delegate to write to VicTrack regarding the (VicTrack) land located to the north of 65A Power Avenue, Chadstone, seeking their view and agreement for a new shared bicycle path to be placed on this land.
- 3. Notes that:
 - a) a request for funding as part of Councils 2024/25 budget process will be made to allow for the design of a new shared path once the outcome of the discussions with VicTrack are known.
 - b) Council will seek State Government funding at the appropriate time for the construction of a new shared bicycle path be it on VicTrack land or in the current location of the existing path along Railway Parade South if VicTrack approval cannot be achieved.
- 4. Directs that officers report back to Council on the outcome of the discussions with VicTrack and their decision once it is known.
- Notes that the Mayor will write to the Minister for Housing and Local MPs to seek their commitment to the refurbishment and improved ongoing maintenance of existing social housing owned and managed by the State Government within the City of Monash.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Notice of Motion is to seek Council's commitment to exploring a new and compliant shared bicycle path and directing Council officers to write to VicTrack regarding the possibility of a new shared bicycle path being located to the north of Council's land at 65A Power Avenue, Chadstone to the (VicTrack) land, adjacent to the rail line.

DISCUSSION

Council resolved at its 31 October 2023 meeting (among other things) to direct its CEO or her delegate to negotiate an agreement to lease and lease with HousingFirst Ltd for the provision of Social Housing on part of its land at 65A Power Avenue, Chadstone.

Council also noted that negotiations will include changes and terms and conditions as resolved by Council at Items 5 and 6 of the 25 July 2023 resolution on this matter.

Item 5 of the 25 July 2023 resolution included the following: "The shared bicycle path must be retained along the Railway Parade South frontage, unless other arrangements are made to relocate it onto the Vic Track owned land to the north of the land."

In accordance with Item 5 of Council's 25 July resolution, officers have created an Indicative Shared Bicycle Path Alignment Concept Plan as shown below and which will be presented to VicTrack for discussion.



CONCLUSION

It is proposed that officers write to VicTrack to understand the possibility of relocating the shared bicycle pathway as shown above.

FURTHER CONSIDERATIONS

The final design and layout of the shared pathway will be determined if and when VicTrack agrees to the use of its land by Council. Should agreement not be reached with VicTrack, the existing pathway along Railway Parade South will be widened instead at the appropriate time and subject to funding as part of Councils annual budget process.
