1.	49 Baird Street	<i>Melaleuca ericifolia</i>	Development is poor and future amenity appears limited, < 2 Years ULE.
2.	16 Redfern Crescent in Baird Street	<i>Acer sp.</i>	Main leader snapped, < 2 Years ULE
3.	4 Baird Street	<i>Acer sp.</i>	Main leader snapped, < 2 Years ULE

\*< 2 Years ULE - with a useful life expectancy of less than two years

### Proposed Species Options.

#### Option 1 – Single species (both sides of the road)

<i>Eucalyptus leucoxylon rosea</i> 'Scarlet' (Scarlet Eucalypt)	
<p>Power line and Non Power line side</p> 	<p>The <i>Eucalyptus leucoxylon rosea</i> "Scarlet" has an exceptional flowering form and is drought tolerant. 'Scarlet' is grafted onto <i>Eucalyptus leucoxylon rosea</i> providing exceptional flowering performance and vibrant flower colour.</p> <p><b>Mature Size (h x w):</b> 7m x 4m  <b>Form:</b> Oval</p>



#### Option 2 - Combination of Species

<i>Pyrus fauriei</i> 'Westwood' Korean Sun (Korean Sun Pear)	
<p>Power line side</p> 	<p>This is a compact ornamental pear tree with a dense growth habit. It has glossy green foliage that changes to bright tones of red and orange in autumn. It is highly adaptable to a wide range of conditions and soils.</p> <p><b>Mature Size (h x w):</b> 4 x 5m  <b>Form:</b> Oval</p>
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Chanticleer' (Chanticleer Callery Pear)	
<p>Non- Power line side</p> 	<p>This tree is an upright ornamental feature tree with dense habit and attractive foliage, clusters of small white flowers in spring. Throughout summer, the foliage is attractive, dark green and glossy. Autumn tones of gold, plum and burgundy.</p> <p><b>Mature Size (h x w):</b> 11 x 6m  <b>Form:</b> Upright</p>

### Option 3 - Combination of Species

<i>Acer campestre</i> 'Evelyn' (Queen Elizabeth Maple)	
<p>Power line side</p> 	<p>This is a small to medium deciduous tree with upright branching habit. Small leaves with rounded lobes dark green in summer turning yellow in autumn. Flowers are green and inconspicuous.</p> <p><b>Mature Size (h x w):</b> 8-10 x 7m</p> <p><b>Form:</b> Round</p>
<i>Acer X freemanii</i> 'Autumn Blaze' (Autumn Blaze Maple)	
<p>Non Power line side</p> 	<p>A medium, deciduous tree with oval to rounded canopy and straight trunk. Features deeply cut green leaves that turn to brilliant crimson-red in autumn. Works well as a feature tree for street landscapes.</p> <p><b>Mature Size (h x w):</b> 13 x 10m</p> <p><b>Form:</b> Oval/Round</p>
