Tree Species Options

Option 1 – Single species (property side of the road)



<i>Eucalyptus leucoxylon</i> 'Eukie Dwarf' (Eukie Dwarf)	
	<p>This shapely dwarf Eucalypt has a light, open canopy with a single trunk and smooth bark that sheds. Its grey-green leaves, once mature, are offset by masses of nectar-rich, pink, red and sometimes cream blossoms from late autumn to early summer, attracting native birds to the garden.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 6-8m x 4-6m Form: Round</p>

Option 2 – Single species (property side of the road)

<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i> (Golden Raintree)	
	<p>This species is an elegant small tree. It has serrated green, pinnate leaves and branches, which droop at the ends creating a slight weeping effect. The foliage turns bronze to gold in autumn. In summer, chains of bright yellow flowers are produced, followed by papery lantern-like seed pods which hang from the tree in large clusters.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 7-10m x 10m Form: Round</p>

Option 3 – Single species (property side of the road)

<i>Callistemon viminalis</i> (Weeping Bottle Brush)	
 	<p>This is a pretty bird-attracting tree with a heavy crown due to the profusion of brilliant red flowers in spring and summer. It is the weight of these flowers that gives it a pendulous habit.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 6-8m x 6-8m Form: Round</p>
