

Proposed Tree Species Options

Option 1 – Single species (both sides of the road)

Lophostemon confertus (Queensland Brush Box)



This is a fast growing tree. Dome-like in shape, it develops a very dense foliage cover of dark green, leathery leaves providing good shade for the summer months. Summer also brings clusters of small white flowers whose stamens give them a decorative fluffy appearance.

Mature Size

(height x spread): 10m x 5m Form: Oval

Option 2 – Single species (both sides of the road)

Ulmus parvifolia 'Todd' (Todd Chinese Elm)

Non Power-line Side



This semi-deciduous tree has a lovely pendula habit with bright green serrated leaves. Its bark is smooth and flaky in various shades including grey, rust brown and cream. In autumn its foliage turns various shades of yellow before falling.

Mature Size

(height x spread): 10-12m x 6-8m Form: Oval

Option 3 – Single species (both sides of the road)

Koelreuteria paniculata (Golden Rain Tree)



An elegant, small tree. It has serrated, green, pinnate leaves and branches which droop at the ends creating a slight weeping effect. The foliage turns bronze to gold in autumn and is held on the tree until quite late in the season. In summer, chains of bright yellow flowers are produced, followed by papery lantern-like seed pods which hang from the tree in large clusters.
