Proposed Tree Species Options

Council’s Street Tree Strategy team has identified the following species using the most appropriate species for the location. Our goal is to strengthen the already established streetscape in Norfolk Avenue, this selection is fitting with the existing established trees along the road.

Norfolk Avenue – Combination of species planted in an alternating pattern

<i>Melia azedarach</i> ‘Elite’ (White Cedar)	
	<p>This tree is fast growing and has showy lilac coloured flowers in summer. It has attractive green bipinnate leaves and yellow bead-like fruits which last long after the leaves have fallen.</p>
<p>Mature Size</p> <p>Height x Width (m): 6 – 12 x 5 – 8 m</p> <p>Form: Broad Domed</p>	

<i>Melaleuca linariifolia</i> (Flax-leaf Paperbark)	
	<p>Tall shrub or small evergreen tree, dense broadly domed canopy, often multi trunked. Linear grey-green leaves. Dense spikes of fluffy, honey-scented cream flowers cover the plant in summer.</p>
<p>Mature Size</p> <p>Height x Width (m): 6 – 10m x 6 – 10m</p> <p>Form: Round</p>
