

Volunteer of the Year

Criteria

This award recognises any person performing voluntary duties, or providing a leadership role on a voluntary basis within the City of Monash, for special service to a particular activity or group within the community.

This category welcomes nominations for people who:

- » Has positively impacted others, or for on-going contribution to the Monash community
- » Inspires, encourages and/or supports others to become involved in their ideas and activities
- » Is a role model to their family, community and/or workplace
- » Years of service will also be considered.

Nomination Guidelines

Here are a few guidelines to assist with your nomination

- » Only **one category** can be selected (not multiple categories)
- » People who were **nominated before can be nominated** again
(Previous winners are unable to be nominated for future awards)
- » Ensure **contact details are correct**
- » **Highlight your nominee's achievements** and provide as much detail as possible
- » **Describe the positive difference** the nominee has made to an individual, group or the community
- » If relevant, **include supporting documentation** i.e. photos, articles and personal references
- » Make sure your submission contains **at least 250 words**
- » Council staff and Councillors are not able to be nominated.
