4.2 TENDER FOR STRATEGIC DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS – DANDENONG ROAD TO WORCHESTER STREET, HUNTINGDALE (CF2020072: PR)

Responsible Director: Director Infrastructure

RECOMMENDATION*

That Council:

- 1. Awards the tender from Comar Constructions Pty Ltd for Strategic Drainage Improvements – Dandenong Road to Worchester Street, Huntingdale, Contract No. 2020072 for a fixed Lump Sum of \$413,277.70 with an extra \$41,730 for Contingencies and \$83,270 for Provisional Items (executable at Council's option);
- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract agreement;
- 3. Notes that the contract will commence on 2 March 2020 and the expected completion date is 15 May 2020; and
- 4. Notes that the anticipated total Project Expenditure including the fixed Lump Sum, Contingencies, Design and Project Management Fees and Provisional Items is \$588,877.70.

(*Please note that all dollar figures are GST Inclusive unless stated otherwise).

INTRODUCTION

Council has tendered for Strategic Drainage Improvements – Dandenong Road to Worchester Street, Huntingdale.

BACKGROUND

During high intensity storm events overland flows discharge from 1558/1564 Dandenong Road through private properties in Garnett Street, Worcester Street to Huntingdale Road following the natural valley.

The combination of low points along 1558 to 1564 Dandenong Road service road and damaged 300mm diameter & 450mm diameter drainage pipes along the front of 1558-1568 Dandenong Road exacerbate the overland flows. The underground drains and pits are to be replaced and upgraded to minimise drainage problems for residents.

Stage 1 works were undertaken in 2018/19 Financial Year (along Dandenong Road and through the private property easements between Dandenong Road to Garnett Street). This Contract relates to Stage 2 or the remaining section of the project.

NOTIFICATION

A public notice was placed in The Age newspaper on Saturday 23 November 2019 and the tender closed on Wednesday 18 December 2019.
