#### **RECOMMENDATION\***

That Council:

- 1. Awards the tender to Prowire Fencing Group Pty Ltd T/A Melbourne Chainwire Fencing, The Fencing Man Pty Ltd and Summerhill Maintenance Services Pty Ltd, for Fencing and Guardrail Services, Contract No. 2019143 for a schedule of rates based contract with an estimated annual contract value of \$150,000 and an estimated total contract value of \$1,200,000 inclusive of all available extension options.; CPI over the contract period is estimated at 2% p.a.
- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer or her delegate to execute the contract agreement.
- 3. Notes that the contract will commence on 1 March 2020 with an initial term of 12 months and the contract has three extension options of two years each and authorises the Chief Executive Officer to approve extension options subject to satisfactory performance.

#### INTRODUCTION

To consider and recommend awarding a tender for Contract Number 2019143 for Fencing and Guardrail Services for an initial term of 12 months with three extension options of two years each.

## **BACKGROUND**

Council is seeking to appoint a panel of Contractors to undertake regular maintenance, repair and replacement works for fencing and guardrails.

Council currently engages the services of The Fencing Man Pty Ltd.

A public notice was placed in The Age newspaper on 6 July 2019 and the tender closed on 26 July 2019.

#### DISCUSSION

The following information supports the evaluation panel's recommendations:

- All three tenderers are capable of meeting the specified requirements and fall within budget estimates.
- All tenderers had also demonstrated a good understanding of the required services.

For this category, the panel confirms that three suppliers are required to satisfy Councils service needs. The final evaluation (including price and non-price evaluation criteria) had ranked the following three suppliers as representing the best value outcome for Council. To ensure best value to Council, tenderers will be invited to provide fixed priced quotes based on the contracted rates for particular projects to determine the most competitive price.

- The Fencing Man Pty Ltd
- Summerhill Maintenance Services Pty Ltd
- Prowire Fencing Group Pty Ltd T/A Melbourne Chainwire Fencing

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The price component was evaluated by applying the scheduled estimated quantities of work based on previous years.

The annual contract price is estimated at \$150,000 (GST inclusive) and is adequate to cover the requirements for this service.

## SUSTAINABILITY OUTCOMES

- Tenderers were required to demonstrate their commitment to achieving environmental sustainability activities for a healthy environment.
- Their policy also incorporates social sustainable practices that provide for the long term unemployed and employment of staff from a diverse background.
- All personnel are also adequately supervised, trained and aware of their environmental responsibilities.
