- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract agreement.
- 3. Notes that the contract will commence on 28 February 2020 and the expected completion date is 26 June 2020.
- 4. Notes that the total anticipated project expenditure including the fixed Lump Sum, Contingencies, Design and Project Management fees is \$498,850.

INTRODUCTION

Council has tendered for Gardiners Reserve – Portable Change Rooms.

BACKGROUND

Eastern Lions Soccer Club is a well-established National Premier League (NPL) community-based club located in Burwood, Melbourne. The club has approximately 20 teams across the competition in the Seniors and Juniors. During the 2019 season, the seniors won the right to be promoted to the top level of NPL in 2020.

As a result of being promoted, Football Victoria has provided the Council with the minimum facility standards required for clubs playing at this level. The southern pavilion located at Gardiners Reserve has only two (2) change rooms and a referee's change room resulting in the facility not meeting the minimum Football Victoria facility requirements. The installation of the Portable Change Rooms will meet the requirement of a four (4) change room facility with referee's change room.

NOTIFICATION

A public notice was placed in The Age newspaper on 14 December 2019 and the tender closed on 22 January 2020.

TENDERS RECEIVED

Three (3) tender submissions were received by the appointed closing time.
