DISCUSSION

The following information supports the evaluation panel's recommendations.

An interview was conducted with Oakleigh Locksmiths to assess their submission in further detail, and to better understand the alternative systems option nominated in the tender specification. The opportunity to clarify the alternative system enabled officers to establish a preferred approach, which Council may undertake to enhance the security keying systems into the future which would offer better patent protection to prevent unauthorised cutting of keys.

The final evaluation ranking (including the price and non-price evaluation criteria) had Oakleigh Locksmiths Pty Ltd ranked highest and as such, the evaluation panel recommends Oakleigh Locksmiths Pty as representing the best value outcome for Council.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The recommended tenderer's price is estimated at an annual cost of \$99,000 (GST inclusive). CPI over the contract period is estimated at 2% p.a. Therefore the estimated cost over a five year period is \$ 515,200 (GST inclusive).

The estimated contract expenditure is to be funded from existing budgets allocations managed by the Facilities Maintenance unit.

CONCLUSION

That Council approves the recommendation contained within this report.
