### 4.2 TENDER FOR OAKLEIGH RECREATION CENTRE POOLS REFURBISHMENT

### **RECOMMENDATION\***

#### That Council:

- 1. Awards the tender from On Time Developments Pty Ltd for Oakleigh Recreation Centre Pools Refurbishment Contract No. 2021108 for the fixed Lump Sum Price of \$529,925 with an extra \$52,800 for Contingencies.
- 2. Authorises the Chief Executive Officer to execute the contract agreement;
- 3. Notes that the contract will commence on 1 July 2021 and the expected completion date is 30 September 2021; and
- 4. Notes that the anticipated project expenditure including the fixed Lump Sum, Contingencies, Project Management & Delivery Fees and Provisional Items is \$602,525.

#### INTRODUCTION

Council has conducted a tender for Oakleigh Recreation Centre Pools Refurbishment.

## **BACKGROUND**

Council is seeking to appoint a contractor to refurbish the Oakleigh Outdoor Pool. During recent years there has been tile failure (glue failure) which has resulted in tiles falling off and the need to repair these areas under water. This failure is consistent across a number of pools constructed during that period of time.

A specialised consultant was engaged to determine the required scope of the repairs. A Project working group was established comprising members from Capital Works, Active Monash and Facilities & Infrastructure Maintenance to plan and deliver this project.

The scope of works include:

- Site establishment of the facility
- Demolition of the failed tiling
- Preparation of the walls and floors to accept new tiles
- New tiling as documented
- Caulking of the expansion joints
- Clean up upon completion of the works prior to refilling the pools with water

The works have been scheduled to be delivered during the outdoor pool winter shut down period (April-October 2021).

#### **NOTIFICATION**

A public notice was placed in The Age newspaper on 10 April 2021 and the tender closed on 28 April 2021.

Additional funding is required to complete the full extent of works.

All works are safety related & required. It is recommended that the full scope of works are undertaken whilst the pools are empty during the winter shut down period.

#### SUSTAINABILITY OUTCOMES

As part of Council's commitment to sustainability this project involves the use of:

- Environmental Sustainability: The contractor will ensure that redundant materials (rubble) are to collected and taken to a base recycling plant, crushing the rubble further to re-use as road base. Plastics and cardboard are separated by the associated bin hire company and taken to the closest recycling plant. All nonrecycled materials will be taken to the closes municipal waste station for recycle.
- 2. <u>Local Sustainability:</u> The contractor has confirmed that 5 staff and sub-contractors reside within the City of Monash. Materials and equipment are to be supplied from local business.
- 3. <u>Social Sustainability</u>: The contractor supports & reinvests some profits back into the community.

#### **CONCLUSION**
